Before you leave, think about the security of your property. Ask a trusted neighbour to pop in and draw/open curtains, switch on/off lights, park their car on your drive, etc to make the home look occupied. A light on a timer switch is also an idea. Lock all doors/windows and set any alarm and secure any garden equipment and furniture away safely. Remember to cancel milk and papers also.

Neighbour Noise What can you do?

- Explain politely to your neighbour that you are being troubled however do approach the matter carefully if you think they might react angrily to a complaint.
- If the problem continues start a diary recording times and dates and keep a record of any conversations or correspondence you have with your neighbour.
- Contact the Environmental Health Dept who will investigate your complaint and take all the necessary action.
